

# Deaths Involving the use of All Terrain Vehicles

## - Alcohol and Drug as Contributing Factors -

*This report summarizes all accidental all-terrain vehicle (ATV) fatalities investigated by the BC Coroner's Service (BCCS) between January 1, 2006 and December 31, 2011. Counts include ATV fatalities occurring both off-road and on public roads. Counts do not include dirt bikes or other off-road vehicles.*

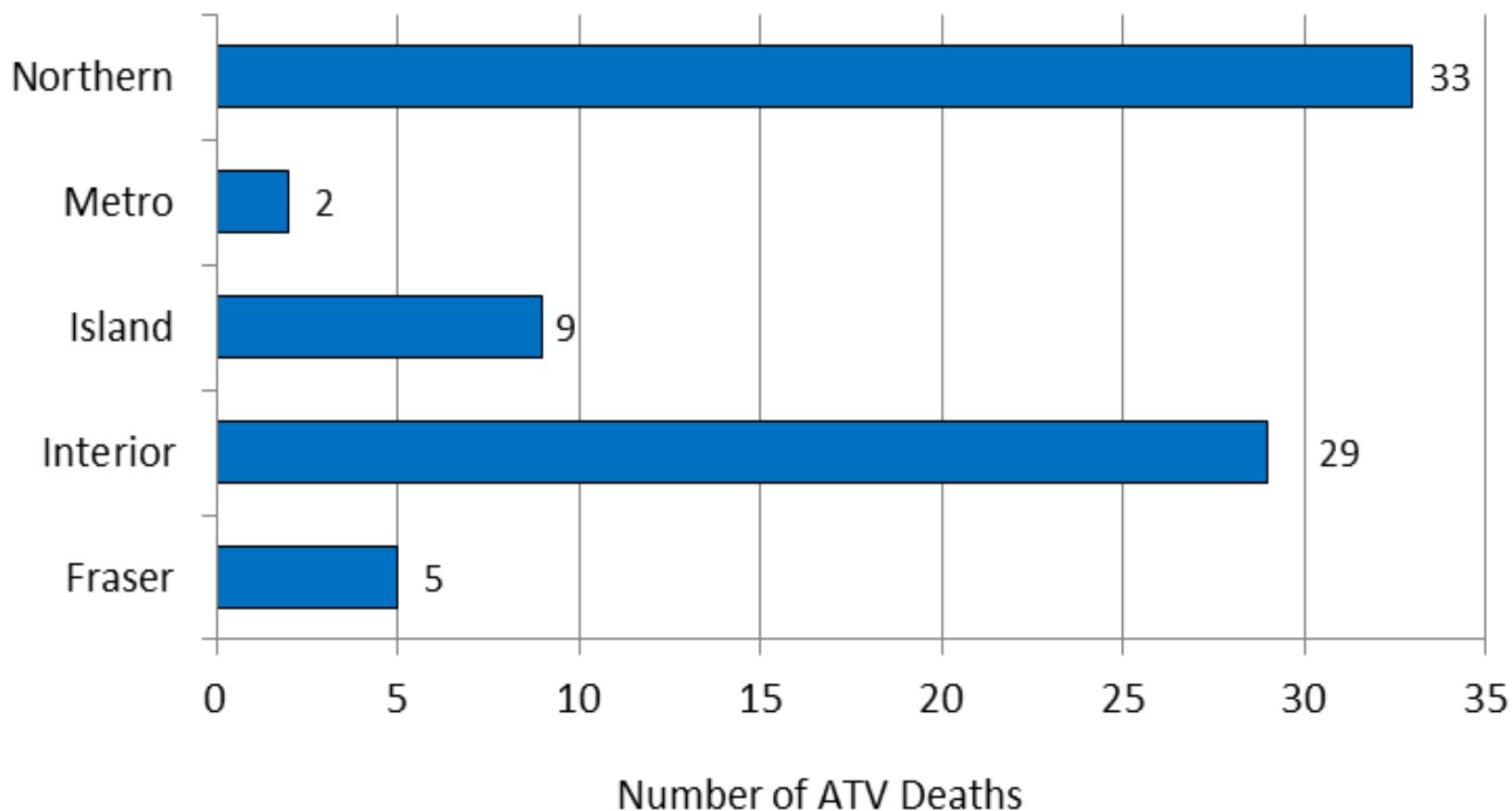

## ATV Deaths in British Columbia by Region: 2006 - 2011



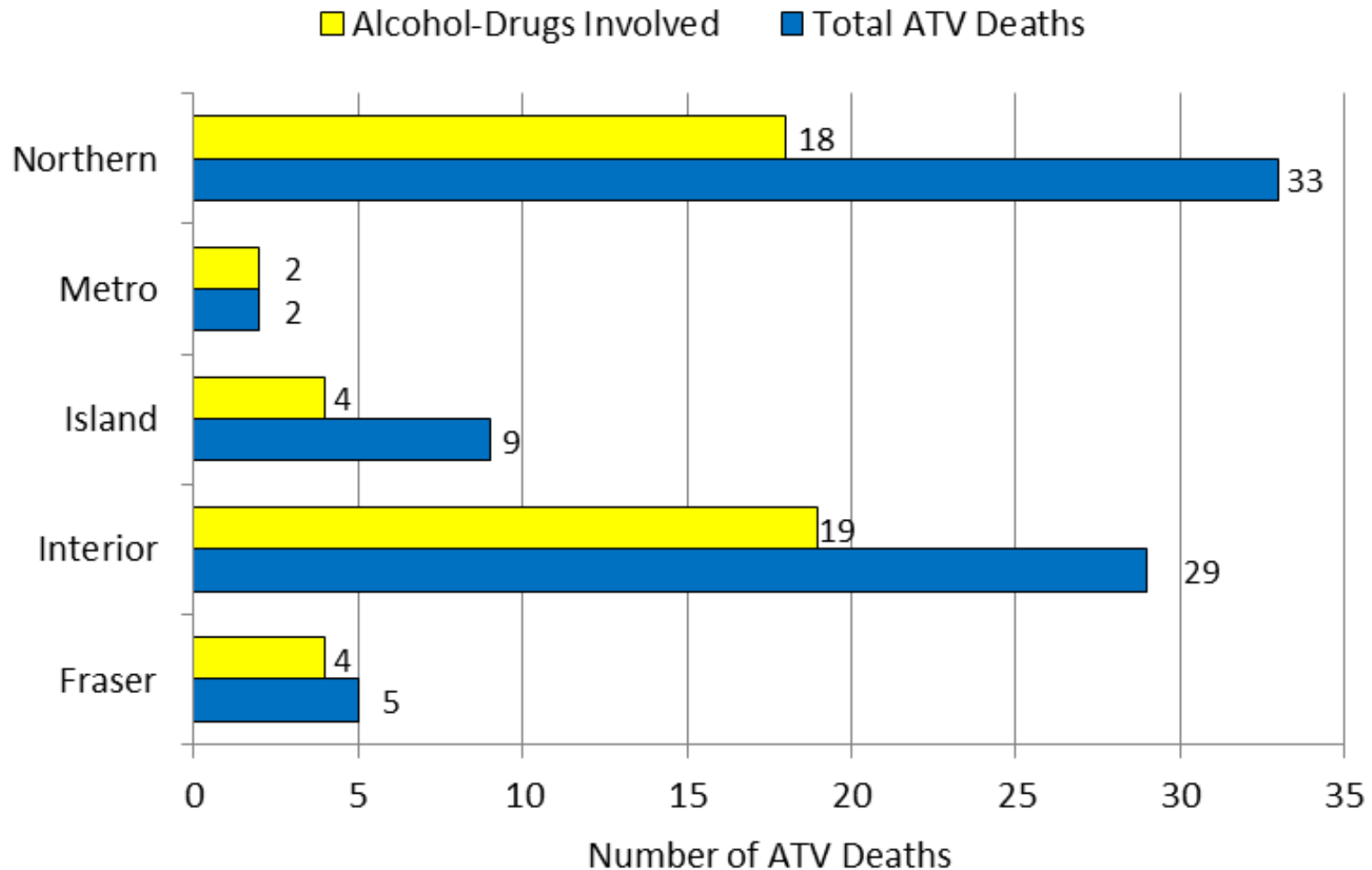
*Northern BC is home to just under 7% of the BC population yet this population accounts for almost half of the ATV deaths that have occurred in the past 5 years.*
