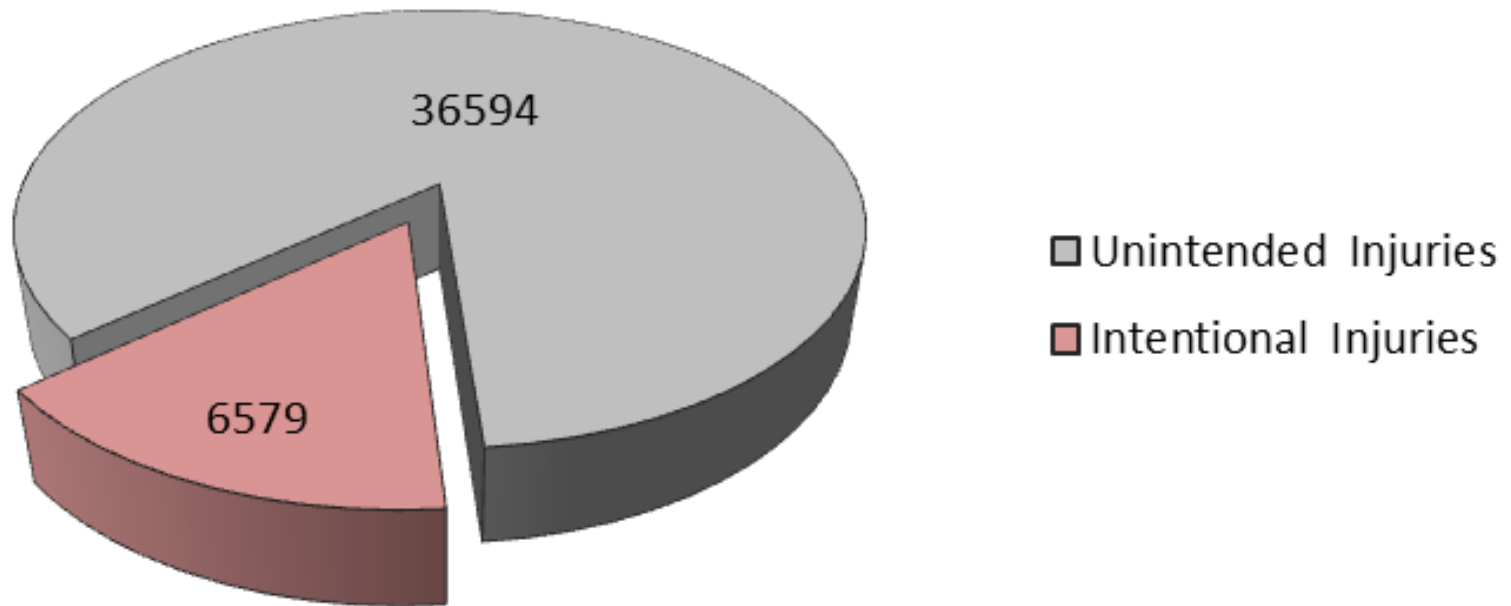

Northern BC: 2001/02 - 2010 /11

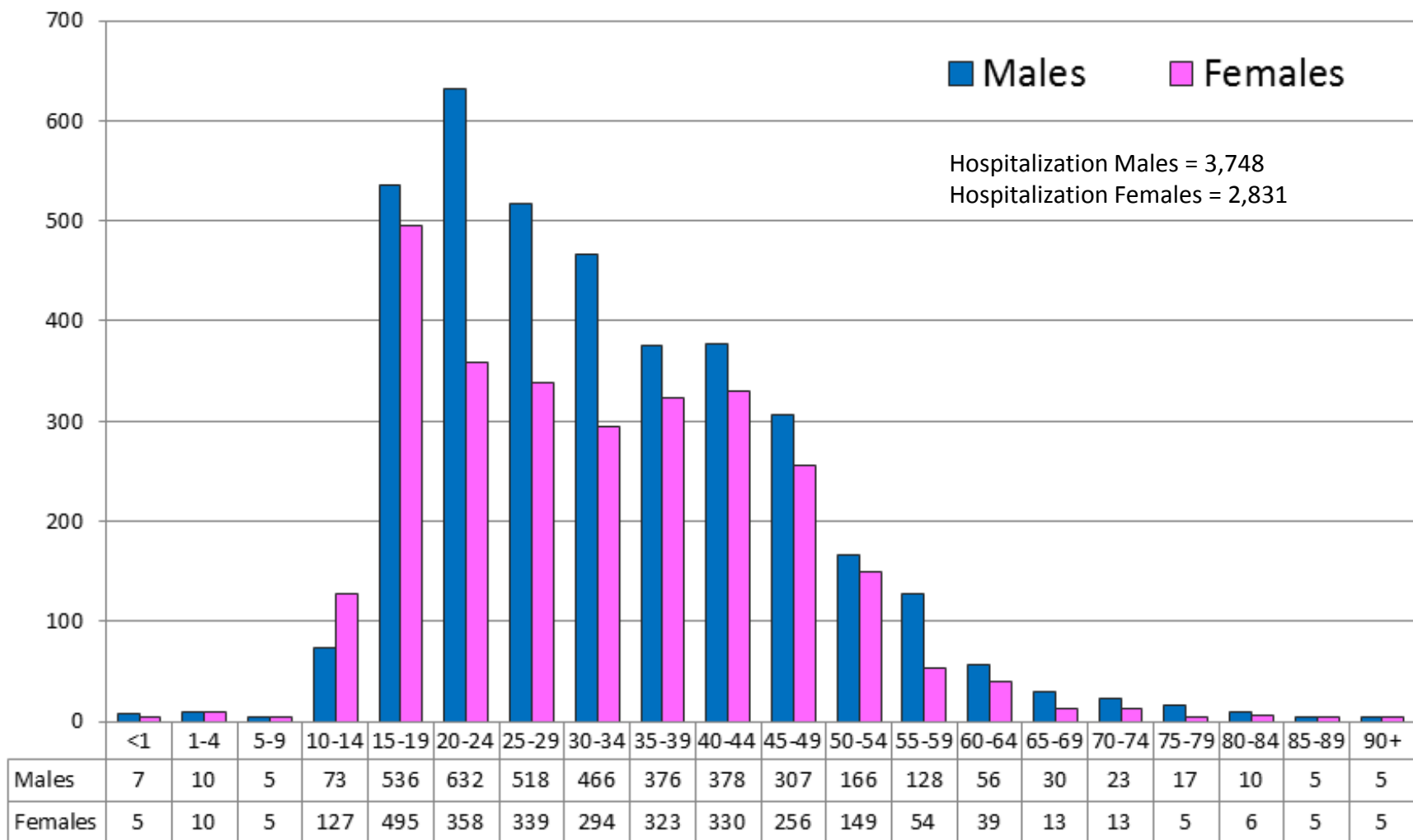


Intentional injuries include: Suicide/Attempted Suicide, Homicide/Assault, Legal Intervention and War.

Unintentional Injuries Include: Transport Related, Falls, Environmental/Natural Factor, Drowning/Submersion, Fire, Flame and Hot Substance, Unintentional Poisoning, Suffocation/Choking, Foreign Body, Struck by Object, Machinery, Cutting/Piercing, Firearms, Explosion/Rupture, Overexertion, Other Unintentional

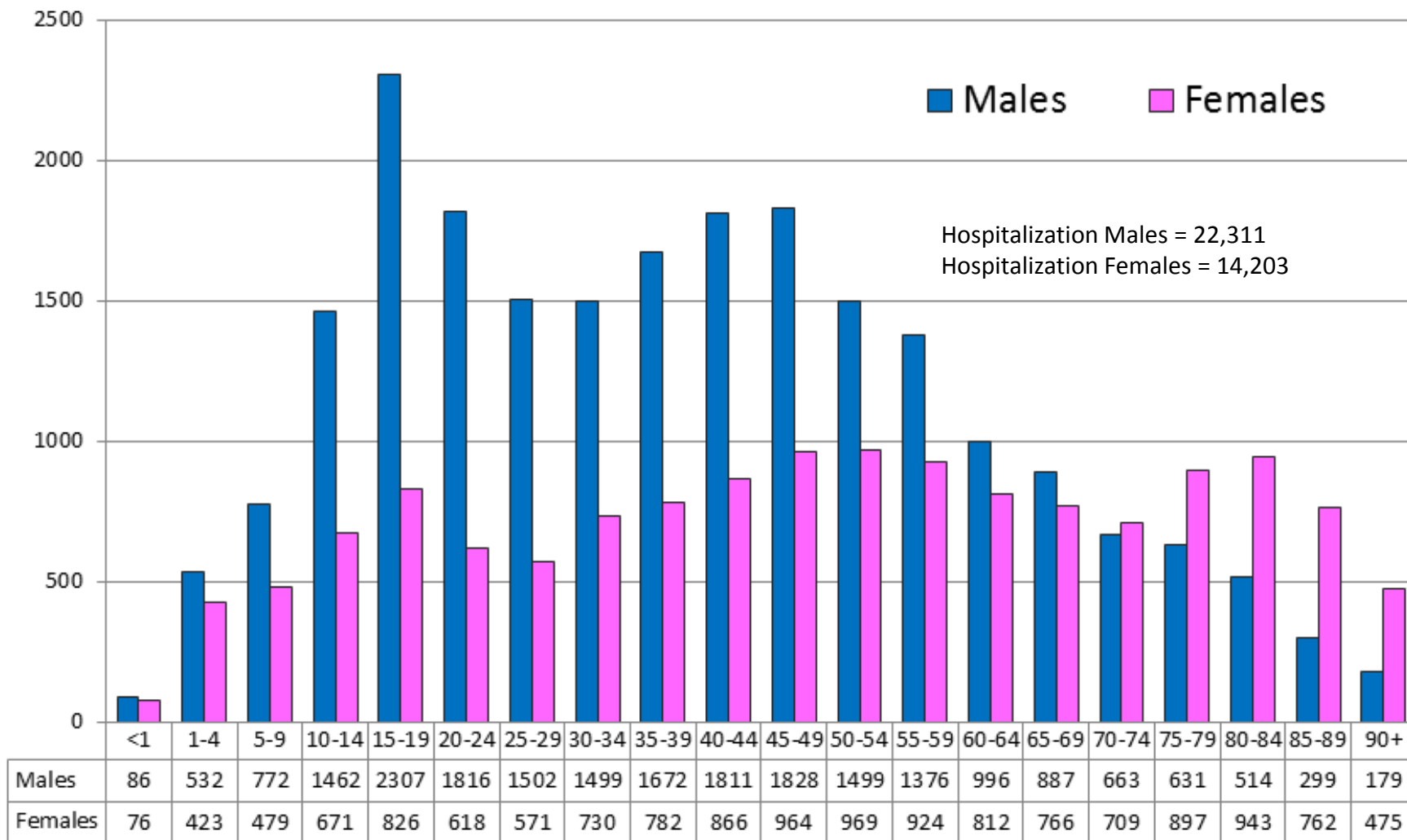
Hospitalizations for *Intentional Injuries* By Age and Sex
