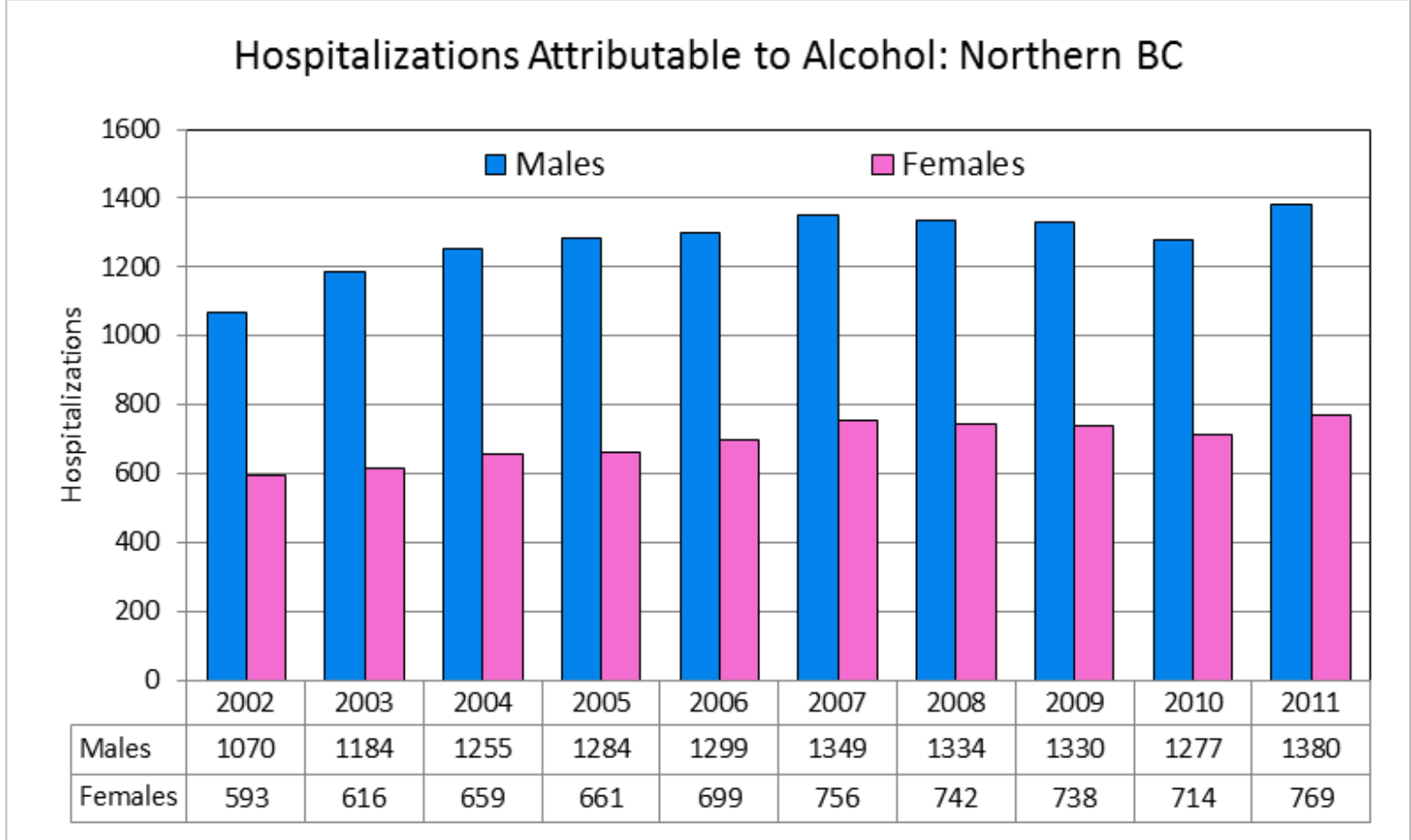

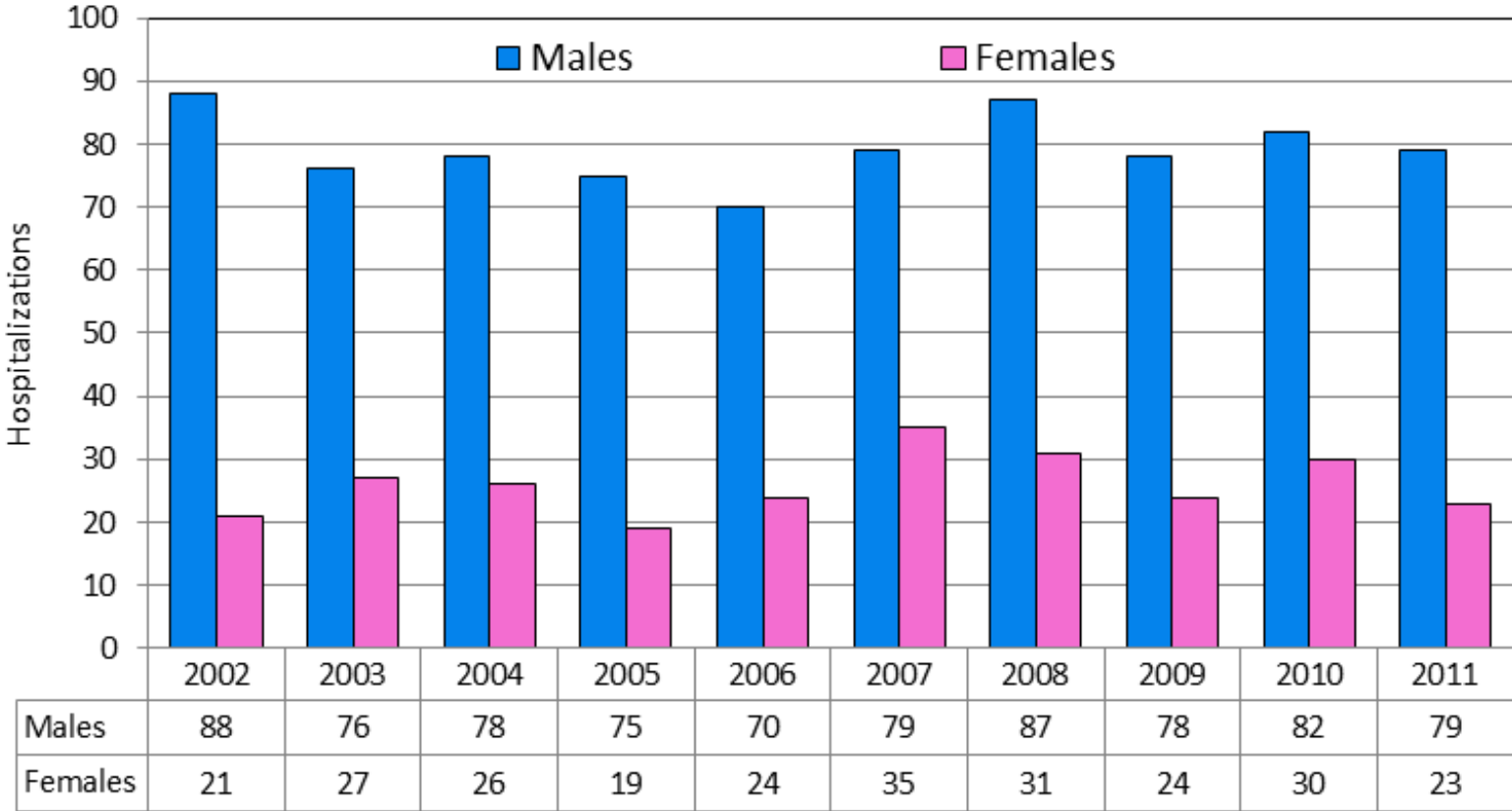

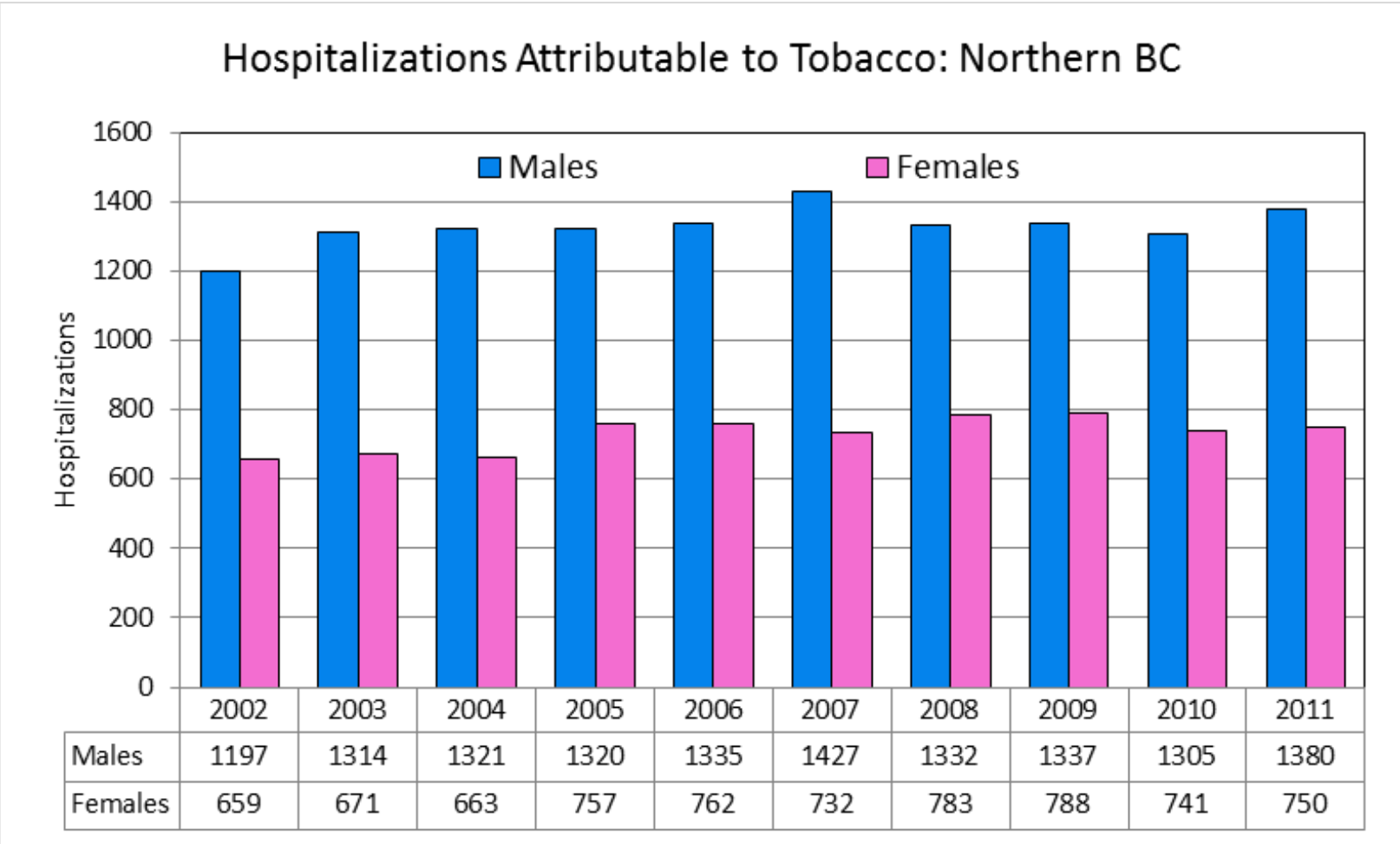
Deaths Attributable to Alcohol: Northern BC

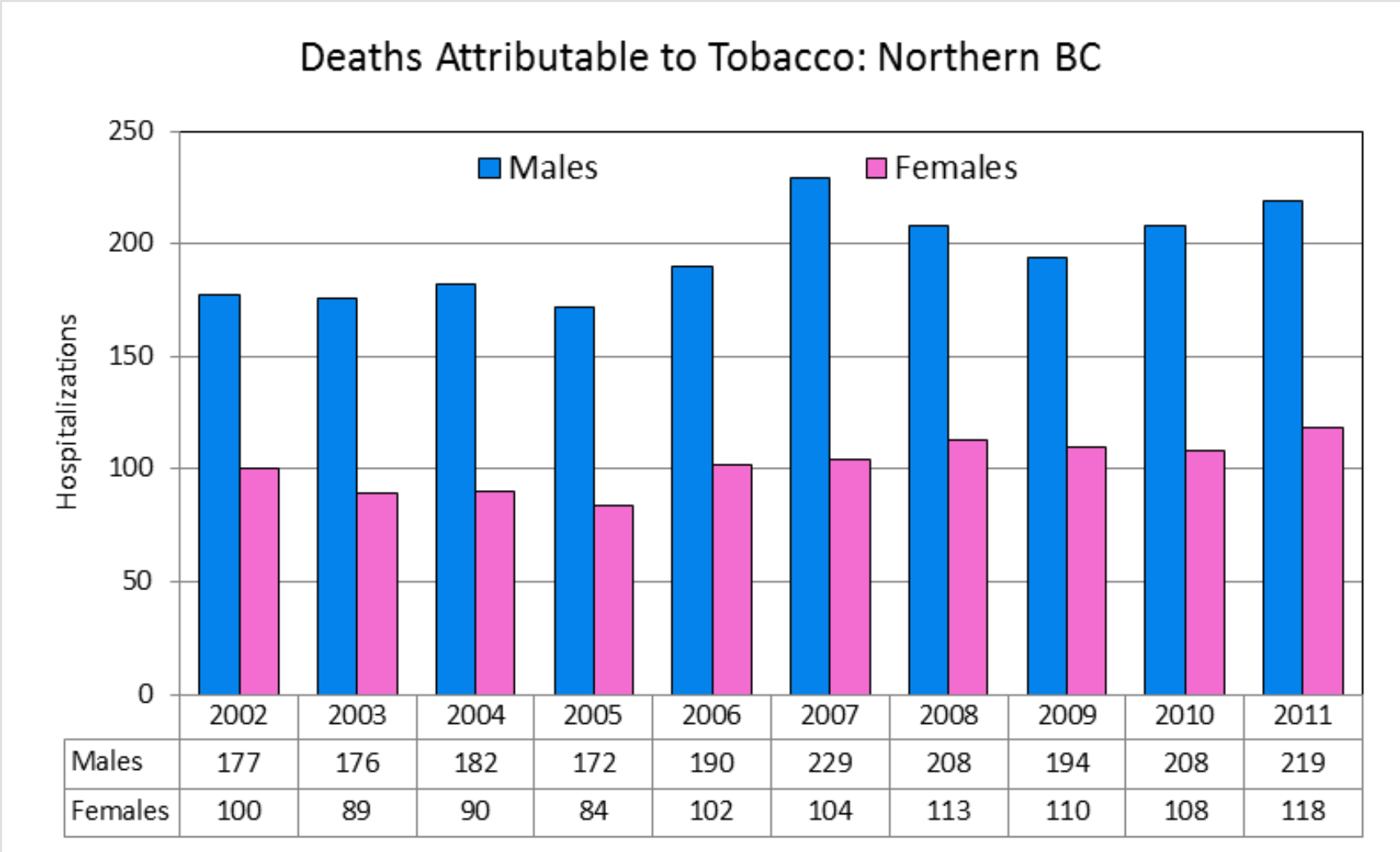

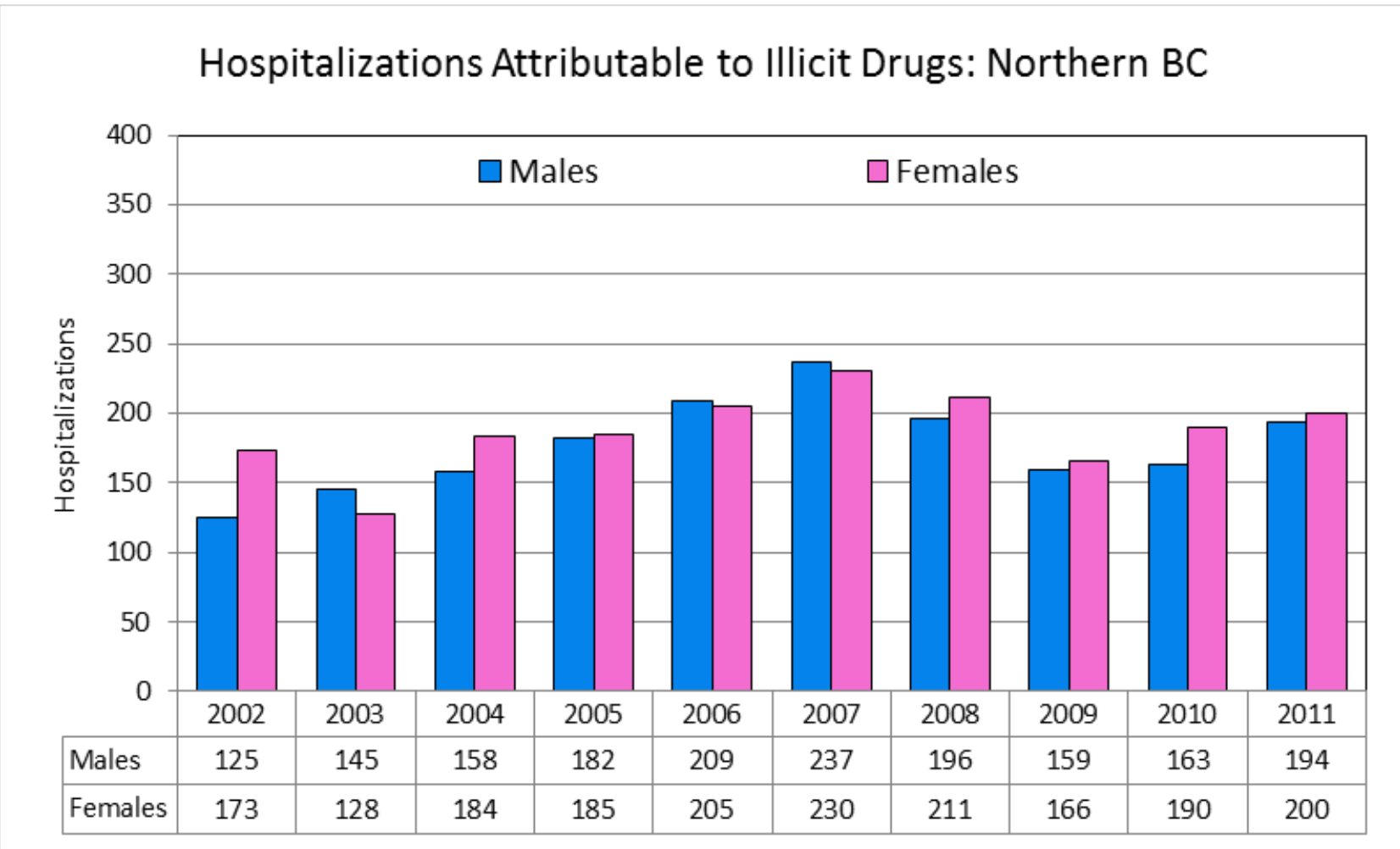

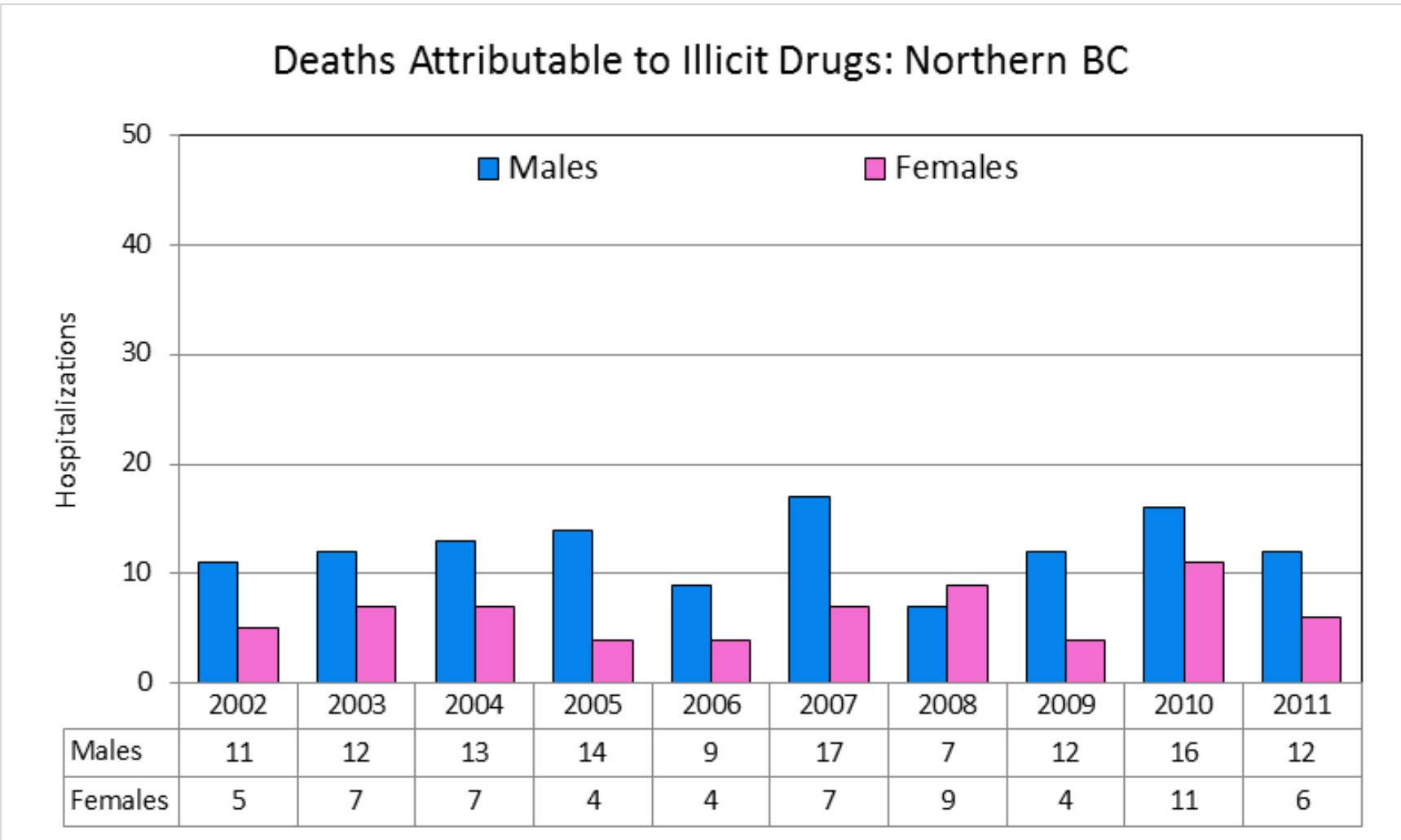
